



A blackout ridge is a very nice solution to get daylight into a poultry or pig house. Daylight from the roof gives the best light distribution across the building, also when the ridge is partly closed.

Every blackout ridge is tailor made, so that you can meet to the 3% light demand.

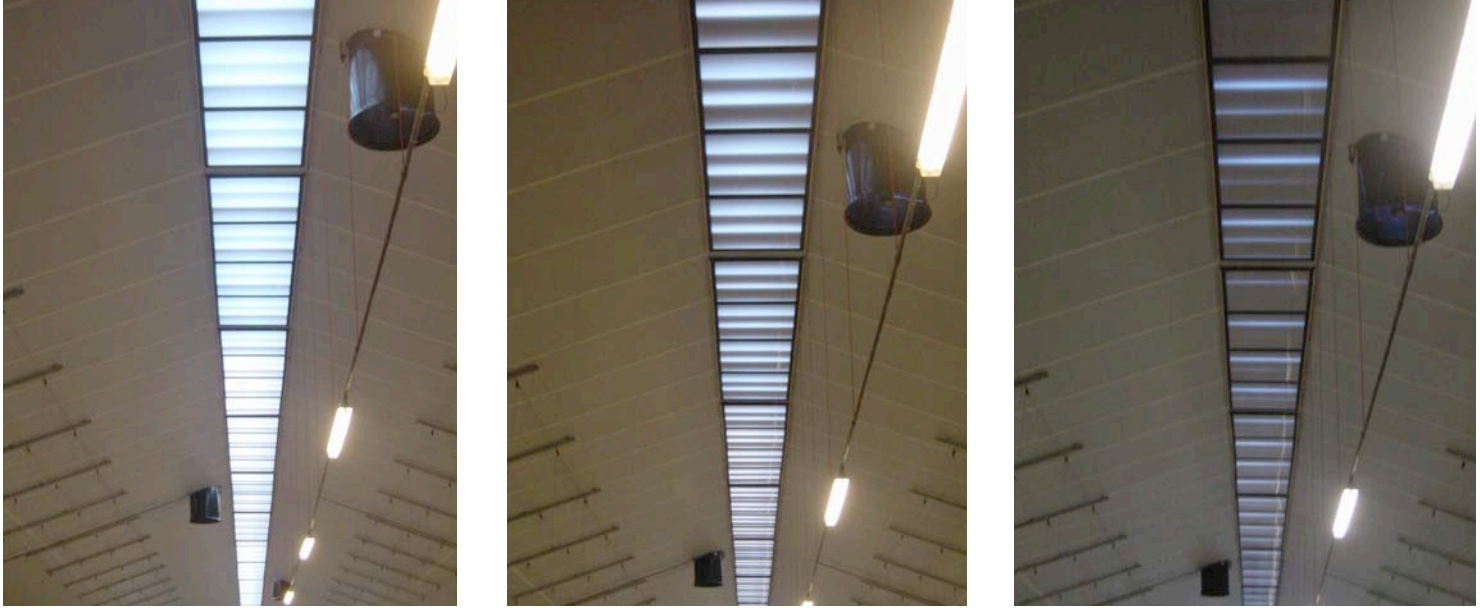
Every blackout ridge exists out of elements (usually 4 each inter-rib). Inside every element movable slats are made to assure proper darkening. The slats can be adjusted with a winching system (electrically or by hand).

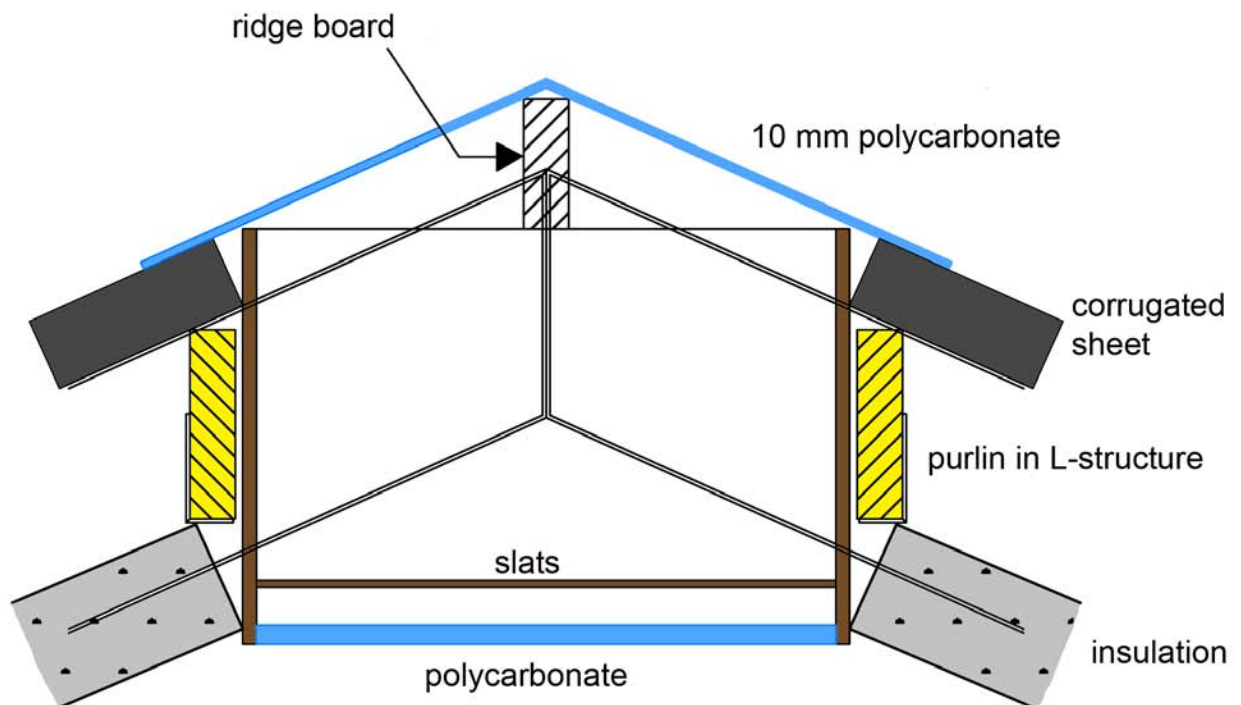

## Technical information



Below you can see a technical drawing of a blackout ridge. This ridge is suitable for newly built stables. For a good connection it is important that the uppermost purlins stand straight in the L-structure (see drawing).

On top of the roof lies a 10 mm polycarbonate plate, beneath lies a 25 mm polycarbonate plate. Together they provide a good insulation.
